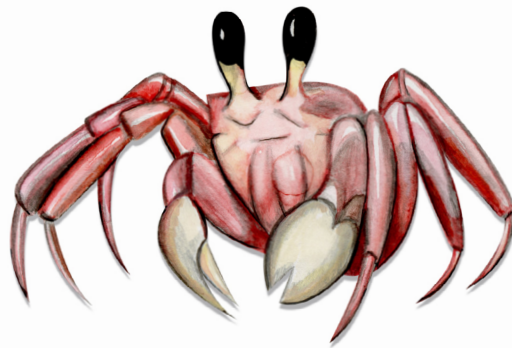

Activity 2: A Poem To Read




“Sand in my Sandals”
