Activity 1: The Lingo

In the episode, Queenie sends Sammy on a birthday treasure hunt, using walkie-talkies to give him clues. That prompts Little Dazzy Donuts to read out a poem about walkie-talkies using several terms that are commonly used by people with walkie-talkies. Those terms are on the left-side below. Can you work out which answers on the right-side map to each term on the left? You can check your answers at the bottom of page 7.
